SHLCS-A03-2024-INR	Warfarin (including acenocoumarol) Initiation and Review in Adults (>18 years)
KEY ELEMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ This LCS provides remuneration for any patient for whom this is the first prescription of warfarin issued by the GP practice. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Patients started on warfarin in primary care ➤ Patients started on warfarin by another provider such as secondary care ➤ Patients newly registered with the surgery and already taking warfarin ➤ In addition - a full review inc. CHA2DS2-VASc & ORBIT/HAS-BLED etc as per PAD: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Surrey Collaborative Anticoagulant Working Group: Primary Care Oral Anticoagulation Monitoring Service Guidelines (Warfarin and VIT K Antagonists) ➤ Reviews must be carried out by a registered HCP, however monitoring can be HCA
OF SPECIAL NOTE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Some performance records are part of the annual submission, but these will be important to demonstrate value of service ➤ Item of Service fees now reflect the difference between in-house INR Star and ICB contracted BPS services, the claim form reflects this (see prices below)
RISKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Exclusions: children <18y, treatment for VTE, bridging for patients undergoing surgery (this is the responsibility of the organisation carrying out the procedure) ➤ SOPs need to be developed for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Service as a whole ➤ Bleeding and over anti-coagulation (consideration to having Vit K in practice) ➤ Managing under anti-coagulation (consideration to having LMWH in practice) ➤ Reassessment of patients with TTR <65% & consider alternatives ➤ Patients who wish to self-monitor
PRACTICE CONSIDERATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must have a named Clinical Anticoagulation Lead, who has responsibility for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Overall service ➤ Ensuring staff are trained ➤ Local networking ➤ Maintain a register, plus call and recall set up
PRICING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Monitoring & dosing appointment - £19.57 ➤ Monitoring and dosing appointment – BSPS - £14.03 ➤ NB most patients will need minimum x 4 PA (12 weekly), ➤ Average annual claims = £78.28 / £56.12 accordingly. ➤ New to INR/warfarin initiation review - £60.96 ➤ Self-monitoring initiation appt. - £129.20 ➤ Self-monitoring 4/52 FU appt - £13.57 ➤ Self-monitoring 6/12 F2F review - £133.11 ➤ Home visit = relevant above claim PLUS - £15.63 ➤ INR NEQAS License, once per practice site p.a. - £168.00
