SHLCS-A08-2024-EAR IRRIGATION	EAR IRRIGATION
KEY ELEMENTS	 Provide an appointment for ear wax removal within a reasonable timescale Check self-care has been followed first (use of drops for minimum 1/52) Ensure service provision is adapted to meet the needs of vulnerable people, including: People living with Down's Syndrome People with learning and physical difficulties People with mental health needs
OF SPECIAL NOTE	 Only ear IRRIGATION not syringing Children are eligible for the service too if operator feels they can tolerate it Can be provided at patient's home, but it is not mandatory to offer this – can collaborate Nursing Homes are expected to provide it themselves
RISKS	 Be sure staff are up to date - contraindications are important LCS mandates use of Patient Leaflet attached to Spec Complex flowchart for management may be different to existing LCSs Beware delegating to HCA -registered professional will remain responsible (GP/nurse)
PRACTICE CONSIDERATIONS	 Do you have equipment already? Does it meet the required standards? Do you have trained staff, or will someone need to upskill?
