SHLCS-A12-2024- SMI HC	SMI - Mental Health Enhanced Physical Health Checks & Suicide Prevention
KEY ELEMENTS	 Incentive payment if the practice reaches/maintains achievement of the nationally set target of 60% for the 6 physical health checks for patients on the SMI QOF register: MH003 - BP and pulse MH006 - BMI MH007 - Alcohol consumption assessment (min first 3 questions of AUDIT-C) MH011 - Lipid inc Cholesterol & QRISK2 (if on anti-psych/overweight/smoker/CV disease) MH012 - Blood glucose/HbA1c SMOK002 - Smoking status
	 Further per patient payment is made for achieving the above PLUS x 3 additional checks: Nutritional status, diet, and physical activity (template assessment) Illicit substances/non-prescribed drugs in the last 12 months (template assessment) National screening programmes (cervical/breast/bowel) – check/encourage attendance AND MH002 – Care Plan as per QOF, suggested template embedded in LCS
OF SPECIAL NOTE	 All patients on the SMI QOF register are eligible (but not those in remission) No exception reporting is accepted for the 60% national target MH 002 is not included for the national 60% target, but is for the LCS per patient payment
RISKS	 For an average 9,000 patient practice, the SMI register will be 65 70% target therefore would be 46, to achieve a bonus of £675 (circa £14.67 per patient) The practice must consider QOF income in addition to the target incentive, to understand overall income
PRACTICE CONSIDERATIONS	 Very important the practice can differentiate between QOF and this LCS Using the right staff, on the right elements to deliver this LCS will be key to affordability Must identify two members of staff (a named GP and Practice Nurse or HCA), to lead on Physical Health Checks The named Leads must complete e-learning training within 2/12 of sign up (funded by ICB) Must make good efforts to contact all eligible patients to offer the Physical Health Check
PRICING:	 Sliding scale bonus (£75 per 1000 patients on the 24/25 practice list) if 70% of the people on the mental health register achieve QOF indicators: MH003, MH006, MH007, MH011, MH012 and SMOK002 £53.45 per patient with 6 QOF checks, a care plan (MH002) & additional 3 checks above
